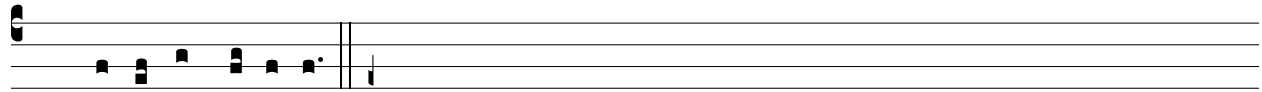


ORATIO DOMINICA (PATER NOSTER)—LONG FORM

vine teaching, we dare to say:



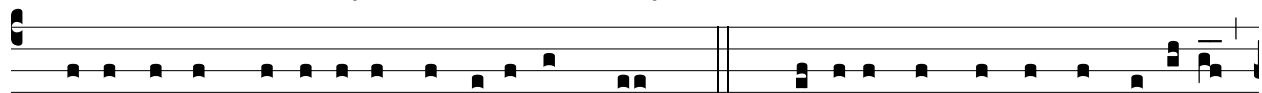

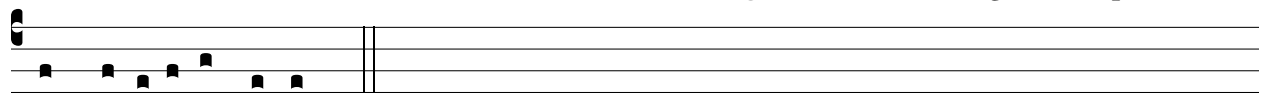
